## FIRST CROP ALL TOO HARD YEARLINGS

The catalogue for the 2016 Magic Millions Gold Coast yearling sale is now available and Australian Champion 3yo **All Too Hard** headlines the freshman sires division.

The five-day auction will commence on Wednesday, Jan 6 and comprises 746 lots in Book 1 and another 270 lots in Book 2.

The catalogue features 13 first season sires headed by Vinery Stud's four-time Group 1 winner All Too Hard (**Casino Prince**).

All Too Hard has 47 lots with 8 consigned by Vinery. "We're really looking forward to getting a nice bunch to Magic Millions to kick him off at the sales," said Vinery's yearling manager Adam White.

"Of our yearlings, 5 are from stakes-winning mares including Group 1 winners Devil Moon and Rightly So.

"The Devil Moon colt (Lot 156) has a lot of quality and should generate a lot of interest, given the ability his sire and dam possessed on the racetrack. Magic Millions has given us great feedback on what they have going to

the sale by All Too Hard and I think he will have the stock to attract a wide range of buyers.

"He was a very talented two year-old having been a Group winner in both Melbourne and Sydney at that age, there will be a lot of sharp, early-looking ones. A champion at three, you would think they will also have the scope to progress further as they get older."

It is well known that All Too Hard had an impeccable racetrack career but he is an all-round sire that has the pedigree and physique to back up his performances.

Being from the dam of Black Caviar, Helsing, All Too Hard boasts one of the best dam lines in the country. Selling as a yearling for \$1,025,000 he also ticks the box on type.

All Too Hard was very popular at this year's Magic Millions National Sale. His first crop weanlings averaged over \$180,000 with 100% clearance and mares carrying his second-crop foals averaged \$170,000.

### FOURTH SW'ER THIS SPRING

**Casino Prince** proved he isn't out of place among the Hunter Valley's leading sires when Mighty Lucky landed the **LR** Festival S. (1500m) at Rosehill on Nov 28.

The Vinery champion is an Australian Top 10 stallion in the black-type division with the winners of 5 stakes races this season. And Mighty Lucky can add another in the **Gr.2** Villiers S. at Randwick on Dec 12.

"The Casino Princes are all lovely horses," trainer Fred Cowell declared. "My bloke loves a fight and the Villiers won't be any stronger than today."

The win on the 28<sup>th</sup> was his 2<sup>nd</sup> Listed victory following last year's Luskin Star S. (1300m) at Scone. "They rolled along nicely up front and he sprinted home well," winning jockey Nathan Thomas said.

Mighty Lucky has matured into a talented sprinter-miler with earnings of \$461,415 and that's typical of the breed. His sire was Australia's Champion First Season Sire in 2011-12 and stakes winners like Hooked, Escado and Casino Dancer are all racing as well as ever as 5 and 6yo's.

Casino Prince has 8 yearlings catalogued for the Gold Coast Magic Millions in January.



### BUFFERING'S SIXTH GR.1

Champion **Mossman** sprinter Buffering was a consummate winner of the **Gr.1** Winterbottom S. (1200m) at Ascot on Nov 21. Vinery stallions have now sired 4 of the last 7 winners of the Perth race.

The 8yo gelding was never headed against a top-class field to win his 2<sup>nd</sup> Winterbottom. It was his 6<sup>th</sup> Group 1 and he clocked 1.08.17s to break the race-record held by **Testa Rossa's** Ortensia.

The cult hero from Queensland was a class above them in the \$1 million sprint winning by a length from Waterman's Bay and Fast 'N' Rocking.

"That was painless," jockey Damien Browne said. "I was confident the whole way and he gave a good kick at the top of the straight."

"He did a super job and is at the top of his game!"

"I was a bit worried on the turn," trainer Robert Heathcote admitted. "I thought he could have been an extra length ahead but

he just kept going.

"I've said it so many times... he's a wonderful, wonderful horse. He's sound, happy and retains his enthusiasm for racing. We will go back home for the Magic Millions Sprint and then look at Dubai and Royal Ascot.

"It didn't work out when we took him to Hong Kong but why not give him another international campaign? We've looked after him. He's in good order and hasn't been over-raced."

Buffering arrived in the west fresh from another successful spring carnival in Melbourne. He won a 3<sup>rd</sup> **Gr.1** Moir S. at Moonee Valley and was just behind the placegetters in the **Gr.1** Manikato S. and **Gr.1** Darley Classic.

Buffering (8g Mossman - Action Annie by Anabaa) earned another \$617,000 in Perth to increase his bankroll to \$5.8 million. He cost just \$22,000 as a yearling from the Racetree draft at the 2009 Gold Coast Magic Millions.



# IN BRIEF

## ART OF RAW

In the same week **Myboy-charlie** celebrated Jameka's Gr.1 win in the VRC Oaks, he had a new stakes winner in France with Art Of Raw. The unbeaten French 2yo cruised to victory in the Prix Delahante (**LR**, 2000m) at Marsalle on Nov 8. The colt led the whole way and won by 2.5 lens. Myboycharlie has sired 8 juvenile winners in France this term and was himself French Champion 2yo in 2007.

## MASTER STEED

**Onemorenomore** sprinter Master Steed (Sienna Star by Choisir) made short work of a restricted sprint in Hong Kong on Dec 2, becoming the 2<sup>nd</sup> winner for Onemorenomore in the territory in a fortnight. The Caspar Fownes trained galloper stretched right out in the straight to win the Dunbar Hcp (1200m) by nearly 2 lens. With jockey Zac Purton on board, he jumped from an outside gate, settled mid-field on the fence and raced to victory from the turn.

## \$200K PLUCK 2YO

A colt by **Pluck** from Oomaroo sold for \$200,000 at the recent Karaka 2yo Ready to Run sale. The brown colt breezed up at a time of 10.92s over 200m and was purchased by Lang Lin and the Rider Horse Group from the from Regal Farm draft. Bred by Peter Arvanitis at

Hillside Thoroughbreds in Victoria, his dam is a Tale of the Cat half-sister to Sydney and Melbourne Group winner Thump (Red Ransom).

## A YOUNG TURF QUEEN

Emtevee Queen (2f **Testa Rossa** – Songs by Fuji Kiseki) recoded her 2<sup>nd</sup> win for trainer Kevin Kemp when she saluted in the Sky Racing Hcp (1050m) at Doomben on Nov 28. The win meant that she qualified for the Magic Millions 2YO Classic but Kemp may bypass the huge pool of prize-money on offer at the Gold Coast and instead aim her for winter carnival races.

## DOMINANT DORTMUND

**Big Brown** colossus, Dortmund, kept his unbeaten Californian record intact with a dominant 4 lens victory in the Native Diver S. (**Gr.3**, 1800m). Returning after a spell for trainer Bob Baffert the massive (17hh) gelding won the Big Bear S. (**LR**, 1600m) first up before his impressive win at Del Mar on Nov 28. Jockey Gary Stevens was impressed saying, "he's a long-striding

horse with a big engine."

"He accelerated to another gear passing Majestic City. He's got sprinter speed but he acts like he can run a mile and a quarter."

Dortmund will now head to the Malibu Stakes (1400m, **Gr.1**) at Santa Anita on Boxing Day.



## MTR COLT FOR \$325K

At the recent NZB 2yo Ready to Run sale **More Than Ready** had two colts on offer and they sold for \$325,000 and \$200,000 while his **Gr.1** Golden Slipper winning son, Sebring topped Day 1 with a \$340,000 colt and another son, **Pluck** had a first crop son sell for \$200,000. The More Than Ready - Imananabaa (Anabaa) colt made the top 10 leaderboard at \$325,000 when knocked down to Warwick Farm trainers Mauro Poletti and Amanda Turner. He was offered by Diamond Lodge and his dam won the **Gr.1** NZ Railway Hcp. "He's a very showy colt with a beautiful head," Diamond Lodge's **Jeremy Whale** said. "He was shown more than most and our reserve was \$200,000. We're over the moon to get \$325,000."

## FEATURED WINNERS

### TELEPATHIC TAKES THE CUP

Telepathic (5m **Mossman** - Telepathy by Conatus) became her sire's 32<sup>nd</sup> stakes winner when she was victorious in the ATC Frank Underwood Cup (2000m, **LR**) at Rosehill on Nov 28.

She jumped from barrier 3 with James McDonald on board and settled nicely on the rail in third last in the early stages. On the turn she stretched out and made up ground before unleashing a long, strong sprint on the straight to win by 1.8 lengths.

Owned and bred by Gerry Harvey in New Zealand, the 5yo bay mare is now trained in Sydney by Chris Waller.

Waller's intention is to drop Telepathic back to the Randwick mile for the **Gr.2** Villiers S. on Dec 12, where she'll come up against re-

cent **LR** Festival Stakes winner Mighty Lucky (**Casino Prince**).

"She was probably a bit vulnerable at 2000m today but had the turn of foot to win," commented Waller.

"Dropping back to the Randwick mile will suit her in the Villiers and I think she will love getting to the big track."



### PERFECT REFLECTION'S PERFECT RECORD

Perfect Reflection (3f **More Than Ready** - Reflected Image by Bluebird) highlighted her star potential when she overcame a setback to win her fourth race in a row in the Champion Fillies S. (**Gr.3**, 1600m) at Ascot on Nov 14.

Recently, a hind shoe came lose and punctured her sole, which meant she missed the Burgess Queen S. and had an imperfect lead up to the race.

"This is always a hard race," said owner/breeder Bob Peters said after she zoomed down the outside to victory.

"She had a setback and missed the Burgess Queen Stakes. We patched her up and it's good to see her come through and win.

Perfect Reflection is a homebred for Bob and wife Sandra Peters and they are no stranger to racetrack success when breeding to Vinery's Champion Sire.

Perfect Reflection is a full-sister to New Image (**LR** Belmont Oaks) and Ideal Image (**LR** Burgess Queen S.) and their dam won the 1999 WA Oaks.

"Perfect Reflection is special," jockey Willie Pike said. "She injured a hoof and then copped more work to get here. It was a pretty good effort."

She holds a Group 1 nomination for the Kingston Town Classic (1800m) at Ascot and has been allotted just 50kg at weight-for-age.





## SALES FEATURE: GR.1 GRADS

Vinery graduates have had another very successful year on the racetrack and the Hunter Valley heavyweight will build on that winning run at next year's major yearling sales.

Delectation led the way in 2015 with an outstanding victory over Chautauqua in the **Gr.1** Darley Classic (1200m) at Flemington on Nov 7. Bred and sold by Vinery partner Greg Perry for \$250,000 at the 2013 Inglis Easter yearling sale, he has already earned over \$1.42 million for Macau-based owner C C Lai.

**More Than Ready** star filly Entisaar added more black-type the Vinery brand this year when named South African Champion 2YO Filly. She was purchased by Sheikh Hamdan for \$300,000 and claimed the **LR** Ruffian S. on debut before stepping up to win the **Gr.2** SA Fillies Nursery and **Gr.1** Allan Robertson Championship.

Champion filly Atlantic Jewel and her three-quarter sister Commanding Jewel were both sold by Vinery at the Gold Coast Magic Millions. Atlantic Jewel was a classic winner of the Thousand Guineas at Caulfield and trained on for further Gr.1 victories in the

All-Aged S., Caulfield S. and Memsie S.

Commanding Jewel also won a **Gr.1** One Thousand Guineas and doubled up in consecutive editions of the **Gr.2** Let's Elope S. at Flemington.

Atlantic Jewel was the pre-post favourite for the 2013 Cox Plate but when she was injured prior to Australia's weight-for-age championship Vinery had a more than able back-up in Shamus Award.

Shamus Award defied being run down at Moonee Valley in the Cox Plate and led all the way to **Gr.1** victory. He proved that was no fluke with another win at the elite level in the **Gr.1** Australian Guineas. Vinery sold him to Bob Hannon for \$230,000 at the 2012 Inglis Easter yearling sale.

He has commenced a lucrative stud career in the Hunter Valley and so has Vinery graduate Rubick who won a **Gr.3** Blue Diamond Prelude at 2yo before resuming as a spring 3yo to win the **Gr.2** Schillaci S.

The 2016 Magic Millions is no more than a month away and there's more of the same quality among the 19 yearlings catalogued by Vinery for the Gold Coast Sale.

## ONE TO WATCH: ZELADY'S NIGHT OUT

On Saturday Nov 14 a 2yo filly by **Myboycharlie**, from the Zedative mare Zelady, had a very exciting win on debut at Doomben.

Zelady's Night Out is trained by Tony Gollan, who was thrilled by her 4 ¼ lens victory in the 1050m 2yo Hcp.

"She was very impressive but you haven't seen anything yet" Gollan said.

Sent out as the favourite, Zelady's Night Out and jockey Jim Byrne jumped well, relaxed nicely and led all the way on the Soft(7) track, clocking a time of 1:01.12, just 0.5 seconds outside the class record.

She'll now head to the Magic Millions Classic (1200m, **RL**) on Jan 9.

Bred by Jilly Henderson at Middlebrook Station, she was purchased from the Yarraman Park draft at 2015 Magic Millions yearling sale for \$65,000 by B2B Bloodstock and Blue Sky Bloodstock.
